I would also like to add that last Sunday, 12/20, when we had that ice storm, my son was stuck on Rich Hill Road for several hours when his car slid off the road, and the salt trucks could not get through on the tiny, pothole ridden, soon to collapse bridge.

Rich Hill Road has been an embarrassment for the 12 years that I have lived in Shawnee Ridge, but now it is unspeakable.

Please please please do something about this. Frankly, we residents are becoming quite annoyed with the passing of the buck of responsibility.

Just to let you know, I have contacted the newspaper and plan to call the local TV stations. Almost losing my jeep in a pothole this morning with probably 10 road workers looking on idly has put me over the edge.
