Thank you for your email. County Executive Onorato asked that I respond on his behalf.

Allegheny County Emergency Services Chief Bob Full has been working directly with Indiana Township officials following last week's explosion. Chief Full has been meeting with Police Chief Bob Wilson and Township Manager Dan Anderson. Please know that the well has been shutdown and will not be approved for operation until the investigation is complete and emergency personnel and OSHA approve its operation. Chief Full also tells me there is private security on site. He will continue to work with Chief Wilson and Mr. Anderson to update them on the progress of the investigation and they will update officials as the investigation concludes. You are more than welcome to be a part of those discussions.
