Parking Ordinance – We had some concerns expressed last night regarding the Ordinance. Especially in Shawnee Ridge. Lorraine Niggle explained that she has at least 7 cars with multiple family members entering and departing her residence at different times (24 hours a day) and is in need of an “exception” to the Ordinance. (i.e. parking on the street) Otherwise she may have to park in front of other neighbor’s houses. She also wanted clarification as to why Shawnee Ridge is restricted at all times throughout the year. This was explained to all attendees. The Board offered Lorraine the opportunity to put her concerns and needs in writing and to submit these to the Manager for review. Once Lorraine completes and submits this letter, these concerns and needs will be addressed at a future Board Meeting.

Also – a copy of the final Parking Ordinance will be placed on the Township Website. (www.indianatownship.com) The website currently shows a “draft” and misstates some of the Ordinance’s allowances. This was an error on the Township and will be corrected asap.
