Old Business:

Rich Hill Road - We will continue to do whatever it takes to make sure that the Harmar portion of this road is paved in 2009. We are doing our best to prevent an unnecessary death.

UPDATE - Jim Burns let me know that Rich Hill Road made the short list to be repaired. It is now a matter of the County approving the funds to Harmar Township. We will keep the pressure on. Please call with questions.

Lauri Ann West -Request for Donation of Funds: Lauri Ann West is expecting well over 200k from Indiana Township for their new facility in Fox Chapel Borough. For this large sum, we may get some low level services at the Brozek Center. We have talked with several District #3 constituents and have a survey posted as well. We have overwhelming support to just say "no" on this issue. We cannot in good faith support this donation. We can open our own library or work with another library center and start up for far less than 200k. Lauri Ann West is clearly NOT looking out for us.

New Business:

Estates of Rural Ridge: I have been communicating with both Craig Scott and Rob Serrao on this issue. I let them know that I have worked with our Engineer and summarized the Home Owners concerns/comments. They were then forwarded to the Developer for another review. When the CEO and our Engineer met with the Developer and Builder over a year ago, they discussed these same concerns/comments relative to the Developer and these same concerns/comments relative to the Builder. The majority of

the concerns/comments outstanding were found to belong to the Builder and are outside the responsibility of the Developer as well as the Township's contractual Agreement with the Developer. These concerns/comments that belong to the Builder remain between the Homeowner' Association and their contractual Agreement with the Builder. I will continue to work with Craig and Rob, as well as all involved parties, to get a solve in this matter, prior to any funds being released to the Developer.

Rural Ridge Parklet -Planned Rural Ridge Parklet improvements - Projects to include, but not limited to; resurfacing of the basketball court, new fence for the back stop and along third base line including repainting the posts/supports. Specific drainage work on the baseball field and replacement of the Pavilion with a larger one. Please take a walk to the parklet today and you will see some of the improvements already underway.
