Recent Robberies:

Attention all Crime Watch Alert members. On Monday 9-13-2010 there was a residential burglary and 2 possible attempted residential burglaries that occurred in the Township. The burglary occurred on Rich Hill Rd. near the Shawnee Ridge plan of homes. During this incident the residence was entered and items were taken from the house. The 2 possible attempted burglaries occurred on Guys Run Rd near Healthsouth. At this time we do not believe that entry was made into either house. If any member in that area noticed any suspicious activity around the hours of 11:00 am and 3:00 pm please contact this Department as soon as possible. You can do so by calling 911 and ask to speak with a Officer from Indiana Twp. The dispatcher will take your info and have an Officer contact you as soon as possible.

Please remember to secure your house when you are away. Also remember to activate your alarm system if you have one. If you do notice any suspicious activity call 911 at the time of the incident. Do not try to stop or question any one that is acting suspicious in your neighborhood. Get a good description of the person or persons and try to see if they are in or around a vehicle. If they leave the area tell the 911 dispatcher which way they went to assist the Officers in locating the individuals.
