Darrin J. Krally - District #3 Report:

KEY VOTES - Keeping consistent to my campaign promises:

RRVFD - I voted **"YES"** to adopt the 2008 budget that adds a fire tax. This will raise approximately \$108,000 that will be dedicated to the volunteer fire departments within our township.

LIBRARY at the Brozek Center – I voted **"YES"** to donate 15k to Lauri Ann West Library Association in 2008. My decision was based on our community's strong desire to finally have a library at our site. I would like to see a library in the building in 2008.

OLD BUSINESS:

RR Senior Programs at the Brozek Center – Our flyer was posted and distributed at the RR Post Office. I will continue working with the RR Seniors in hopes of getting various programs off the ground. I am always looking for both volunteers and input from members of not only the district, but also the township.

RR Estates Maintenance Issues – Rob Serrao and I are working together on this. Rob needs to inform us what exactly needs to be done. We will meet again in the spring.

RR Estates Townhome Owner – Lori Doult – 2024 Arbor Ridge Court – 412 826 0009 - I called and left Lori a message on 12/31/07 to talk with her about her driveway situation. Lori and I talked on 1/1/08 and she let me know that things have not changed with the driveway.

Adelphoi Village – Eric and I continue to talk on a regular basis. The school is progressing and growing. They may require additional space in the future. Dan and I plan on talking with Eric after the holiday season to discuss the meaning of their request a bit further.

Brozek Center - Additional Rental Income is approximately \$300 as of the time of this report. We would like to see this increase in 2008. The dry wall for the new recreation room will be complete by 1/7/08.

Marshall Hill Road – Listed for repair in both 2008 and 2009.

Rich Hill Road – We will work with the new Harmar Board to obtain a long awaited solve and get this road fixed and/or repaired. This is of immediate concern to many of the residents that live on/near this road.

Little Deer Creek Road – Continue to clean up fallen/damaged signs. Roth Site Plan – this is a proposal that will go before the Planning Commission on 1/16/08.

NEW BUSINESS:

12/31/07 – I followed up with Judy Graca regarding a potential Program Director for the Brozek Center. She mentioned Maria Bove. (Former Boyd Program Director) Maria is very interested in helping us do a few things. Maria will potentially both create and present a proposal to the Board of Supervisors talking about these things for our Community Center:

- *Coordinate Educational Classes
- *Pay the room fees
- *Set up instructors
- *Take a small hourly fee from the Instructor's fee
- *Coordinate Membership Program
- *Conduct fund raisers
- *Coordinate a dance/cheerleader program

Judy provided Maria's email address. I will contact Maria via email today (12/31/07) and discuss her intentions today.

12/31/07 – Doreen Benkoski (366 Melody Lane) – I spoke with Doreen and let her know that Our Code Enforcement Officer, Jeff Curti, will follow up and make suggestions. She is still very upset with her neighbor and is looking for a resolution.

12/31/07 – Jim Prato expressed a potential need for a stop sign for Rich Hill/LeFever Hill Road. Chief Bob Wilson will be contacted after the 1st of the year to make a recommendation. I left Jim a VM with this information.

12/31/07 – Thank you for visiting and utilizing www.darrinjrally.com. We experienced well over 100 hits in December 2007. Please continue to visit the site as polls will be taken on the site as well.

1/1/08 – I talked with Lori Doult – RR Townhomes - Lori expressed a concern that the RR Estates Mgmt Company will be cutting services to the townhome community. She was unsure that the Mgmt company

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could execute this since the services are listed in the by-laws. She was to put together a list of her concerns. To date, I have not received anything from Lori.
