As we have discussed at your February Board Meeting, the condition of the Harmar Township portion of Rich Hill Road is atrocious. As noted at this meeting, I do believe we are all in agreement of this fact. Several hundred of my constituents are ready to do what is necessary to achieve the goal of paving this section of the road in 2008. Several petitions are currently circulating throughout our District.

I do understand that both you and your township officials may not have dedicated the funds in your 2008 budget to pave your section of the road in 2008. If this is the case, I am hoping we can find another solution. As County Councilman, Nick Futilies stated, he believes that Harmar Township has a liability issue at hand and agreed that Harmar Township must find the money to make these repairs ASAP. Our goal is to make this happen before a serious injury or an unnecessary death occurs due to the condition of the Harmar section of the road.

I am extending support in the form of Dan Anderson, our Township Manager and our Board of Supervisors. Dan is quite knowledgeable about obtaining CBDG grants and tracking down additional funds for large projects such as the paving of your portion of Rich Hill Road. I know that both Dan and Annette (your Township Secretary) are trying to schedule a meeting to discuss possibilities.

I would like to know your position on this very serious matter. Please contact me immediately to discuss this issue. I would like to report back to my constituents at our 3/11/08 meeting.
