

Harmar looking to raise taxes by nearly 2 mills

In other business:

Supervisors agreed to apply for two grants through the Allegheny Valley North Council of Governments totaling \$400,000 for paving Rich Hill Road.

"That's the minimum dollar amount we need to pave one mile of Rich Hill Road," township Engineer Larry Seiler said.

Rich Hill Road begins in Harmar and runs into Indiana Township whose officials have been lobbying Harmar to pave the its portion of the road, claiming it's in disrepair.

Noll said she hopes to be able to pave the township's one-mile stretch next year, if the grants come through.
