## **Harmar supervisors pleased with financial situation**

The Harmar supervisors said they're pleased with the township's financial situation midway through the year.

Chairwoman Barbara Noll said a special budget review meeting was scheduled Tuesday to brief supervisors and the community on where expenses and revenues stood. The township has collected almost half of its expected revenues for the year. It has spent about 40 percent of its \$2.6 million budget.

Collection of delinquent real estate taxes has been better than expected, and police spending is down from last year. Utility and fuel costs continue to climb, the township needs to begin setting aside more money for future road work. There are two outstanding loans that will take a few more years to pay off.
