Letter to the Editor

Dear Deb:

My name is Darrin J. Krally and I am an Indiana Township Supervisor. Within our District lies Rich Hill Road. Indiana Township owns 3 miles of the road and Harmar Township owns 1 mile. Our section of the road was paved 3 years ago and is in good condition. Harmar Township's section was paved about 20 years ago. The Harmar Township portion of Rich Hill Road is treacherous. It is riddled with large and small potholes, large rocks, and loose gravel, broken logs along the roadside and very hard to see yellow lines. Bottom line –their portion of the road is an accident waiting to happen!!

I spoke at the Harmar Township February Board Meeting and asked their Board of Supervisors to approve a complete paving of their portion of Rich Hill Road in either 2008 or 2009. Unfortunately, my request was not taken seriously. Indiana Township is glad to offer both guidance and support to Harmar, but it is not our responsibility. Harmar owns their section and has an immediate obligation to fix this death trap immediately!

I have several hundred constituents behind me. They are ready to do whatever is necessary to achieve the goal; have Harmar Township Officials vote "YES" to completely repave their section of Rich Hill road in 2008. I am asking your help. Please consider publishing this note as a "Public Notice" pro bono.
